INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION PROGRAMME

Our International Foundation

Programme (IFP) has been specifically developed for international students who want to study for an undergraduate degree.

It is a full-time programme and provides students with the knowledge, skills and confidence to embark upon undergraduate studies at a UK university.



For those who do not meet the IELTS or academic requirement for the International Foundation Programme, we run a **Pre-sessional course for the Intensive Foundation Programme**. This course develops the necessary language skills to undertake the **Intensive International Foundation Programme** at WE Bridge Academy.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSES

Learning English in Cardiff couldn't be easier. Flexibility is at the heart of all of our English courses – with continuous enrolment

and no complicated entry requirements.

Our English language classes provide a professional and relaxed learning environment where students are helped to develop the four essential skills of



language communication: speaking, listening, reading and writing.

All of our English language courses are suitable for students aged 16 and over and carry a one-off, non-refundable registration fee of £150.













// GENERAL ENGLISH COURSES

// ENGLISH + COURSES

Our **English**+ courses combine general English tuition with the benefit of adding **IELTS** or **English for Specific Purposes** (ESP).

All English+ courses offer continuous enrolment and no complicated entry requirements.

Maximum class size: 15 students.

Morning classes normally start between 9:00 and 9:30 and finish between 12:15 and 12:45

Afternoon classes normally start between 13:00 and 13:30 and finish between 15:00 and 16:15





// ENGLISH + IELTS

As well as improving their general language capability, students learn, and practice key skills and exam techniques required for the IELTS exam.

IELTS 21 hours

// ENGLISH + ENGLISH FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES (ESP)

Each ESP course focuses on career-specific vocabulary and contexts and is combined with a General English programme in order to develop your overall English language skills in speaking, listening, reading and writing. These courses can benefit professionals who want to develop their English communication skills for a work environment.

PRE-SESSIONAL ENGLISH COURSE

The Pre-sessional English Course develops the necessary language skills to undertake University Foundation Programmes and Degree courses.

Course lenght

8 weeks

The course includes 6 weeks of tuition and 2 weeks of self-study.

Entry requirements

Students applying for this course must satisfy the following conditions:

- UKVI IELTS or equivalent, minimum overall grade of 5.5, with no individual element lower than 5.0
- Evidence of a successefully completed secondary education (12 years) in an appropriate range of subjects.

WEBRIDGE FOR AVIATION

WE Bridge Academy English for Aviation course will offer you the tools to reach the language skills required to pass the mandatory ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organisation) Level 4 test.

With our 2-week intensive course you will be able to meet and maintain the ICAO language proficiency standards required for pilots and air traffic controllers.

The course delivery can be face toface or online.





Typical content includes:

Air travel, airports, ground handling equipment and personnel, runways and taxiways, meterology and air traffic operations, aircraft types and parts, damage and failure to aircraft, emergency situations, navigation equipment, air traffic management, flight plans, etc.

There will be a focus on developing students' listening and speaking skills, as these two skills are the most important to master in an aviation context.

We understand how important it is to secure the accommodation during your studies, and we ensure that all our homestay accommodations are pleasant, comfortable and a safe place to stay.

Our Academy cooperates with an extensive network of homestay providers and our Student Accommodation & Welfare Officer works hard to find the right accommodation for you and will provide you with all the information you need prior to your journey to the UK.

// What you can expect

- English-speaking hosts to practice your English language skills
- A single room on a half-board basis for students aged over 18.
 Students will be provided with breakfast and dinner
- A single room on a full-board basis for students aged under 18.
 Students will be provided with breakfast, a packed lunch, and dinner
- Most of our Homestays are situated a maximum of 45 minutes from the school by public transport

Each home is inspected to meet British Council quality standards:

- A maximum of one student per nationality will be placed in each home
- Homestay providers are DBS (police) checked
- Homestay accommodation providers are required to provide gas safety inspection certificates
- All providers receive safeguarding training and are required to take part in an induction provided by our Student Accommodation & Welfare Officer

// Services

- The homestay provider will supply bedding and towels
- Laundry will be done once a week



// How to Book

Homestay should be requested at the time of applying for your course. If you didn't, you can apply here.

- **1.** You must complete the form at least four weeks before your arrival to the UK.
- **2.** Homestay accommodation cannot be booked without a completed form.
- **3.** Accommodation will only be secured when payment is received for the first 4 weeks' homestay costs, at least 4 weeks prior to your arrival. Please view our Terms and Conditions for more information.
- **4.** Homestay fees are payable in addition to course fees.
- **5.** Students aged under 18 must stay with a WE Bridge Academy homestay provider, or with a family member with the written permission of their parent/guardian you will need to complete an Accommodation Consent form.









// Important Information for Students Aged 16 and 17

In our commitment to safeguarding students aged under 18, a Parental Consent form is required as part of the application process. We are unable to start the process of allocating homestay accommodation until we receive the following:

- Completed Parental Permission form signed by the parent or quardian
- Proof of identity for the parent or guardian (i.e. copy of passport or driving license)

// Private Rental and Student Accommodation

If you are looking to stay in the city centre, our Student Accommodation and Welfare Officer can put you in touch with both private rented and student accommodation providers.
