// Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA)

An ETA gives you permission to travel to the UK and study on a course up to 6 months. It costs £16 to apply for one through the UK ETA app or the GOV.UK website.

// Who can get an ETA

Whether you can get an ETA depends on your nationality as shown on your passport.

Nationalities from the following locations (including associated territories) can <u>apply for</u> <u>an ETA</u> now:

You can also <u>apply for an ETA</u> now if you have a passport issued by Taiwan which includes the number of the identification card issued by the competent authority in Taiwan.

// Before you start

You need:

- the passport you'll travel with not a photocopy
- access to your emails
- a credit card, debit card, Apple Pay or Google Pay

You'll need to upload or take photos of the:

- passport
- face of the person applying

You do not need to enter your travel details.

// How long it takes

You'll usually get a decision within 3 working days, but you may get a quicker decision. Occasionally, it may take longer than 3 working days.

// After you apply

You'll get an email confirming you've got an ETA. Your ETA lasts for 2 years. You can travel to the UK as many times as you want during that time. If you get a new passport, you'll need to get a new ETA.

An ETA does not guarantee entry to the UK.

// What you cannot do with an ETA

You cannot:

- stay in the UK for longer than 6 months
- do paid or unpaid work for a UK company or as a self-employed person, unless you are doing a permitted paid engagement or event or work on the Creative Worker visa concession
- claim public funds (benefits)
- live in the UK through frequent or successive visits
- marry or register a civil partnership, or give notice of marriage or civil partnership
